ZIMBABWE'S BLOOD DIAMONDS

How Zimbabwe's elite are pillaging the Chiadzwa diamond fields to enrich themselves and finance the violence that keeps them in power.



The Kimberley Process, which is set up to fight the production of blood diamonds in the world, is holding their Annual Plenary session in Jerusalem 1-4 November.

Shamiso Mtisi, an environmental lawyer and Head of Research at the Zimbabwe Environmental Law Association, who is participating in the Plenary will comment on the outcomes of the plenary and possibilities for the Kimberley Process to make a difference for the people on the ground in Zimbabwe.

Tor-Hugne Olsen, Co-ordinator of the Zimbabwe Europe Network will inform the meeting of the efforts of European organisations to support work on transparency in the extractive industries in the country.
